Choose solid hardwood raised panel doors in medium or bleached oak. Decorative glass accents the living room overheads. Dinettes are



framed in aluminum—not wood like some motorhomes. Tops and sides are padded for extra comfort.

### BEHIND THE RICH DECOR IS QUALITY CONSTRUCTION.

Holiday Rambler rolls out ahead of the competition with some of the most rugged construction in the industry. We take the time to test new ideas before they go into production. So when you get your Holiday 1000, you can count on features that are tested and proven. The extra effort pays off in years of extra comfort– and extra value–down the road.

Cabinet doors in all units are solid hardwood and mortise-andtenon jointed. Other manufacturers use hollow core doors which are stapled or mitered together. Frames are stile constructed, then attached



to the aluminum frame to prevent sagging.

Drawers slide out smoothly on low-friction drawer glides. Positive catches ensure that cabinet doors open easily, shut firmly.

Extra water pump switches in the bathroom and the extra radio switch in the bedroom have been added for your convenience.

The framing under dinette seats is aluminum—not cheap plywood. It's stronger and more durable.

Exterior seams, compartments and fixtures are sealed with a Dow Corning silicone that's formulated to last 30 years.

It's the same type of construction found in many aircraft: interlocked two-way welded 11/2" C-channel aluminum superstructure, with studs 24" on center. Nobody else has it. And for lightweight strength and durability, nobody can beat it.

2. The Alumaframe superstructure allows wiring to be easily routed anywhere. Protective thermoplastic grommets between the wiring and frame prevent electrical problems down the road.

3. Holiday Rambler design engineers create clay prototypes to test sizing, symmetry, and aerodynamics of motorhomes. This, combined with computer-aided design, gives Holiday Rambler a technological advantage over most competitive motorhomes.

4. A corrosion-resistant aluminum sheet barrier below the frame helps keep the road grit, grime and moisture outside the coach. Blandex<sup>®</sup> wood flooring eliminates seams and resists moisture which can cause costly reflooring. 5. Holiday Ramblers are doubleinsulated. Interior paneling, bead foam and craft paper are laminated together and fastened directly to the superstructure. The 11/2" R-5 fiberglass insulation is hand-fitted in the frame. The durable fiberglass outer skin is riveted on.

6. Holiday Ramblers have plenty of basement storage—up to 110 cubic feet in some models.

### LOW-MAINTENANCE FEATURES TO LOOK FOR,

We understand that you've got better ways to spend your time than performing constant maintenance, so we've designed in the quality you need to make your travels as carefree as can be.

Check the seals on windows and doors. All Holiday Rambler models feature radius self-sealing rubber gaskets around windows. This keeps moisture from pooling in the seams and helps keep your coach weathertight. The rounded seal means there's no need for caulking which can cause ugly stains and crack over time.

Take a close look at roof construction. Many manufacturers use flat, one-piece roofs which can actually prevent water from running off. Holiday Rambler's exclusive tapered roof is pitched 1 in. per 4 ft. It slopes away from the center and minimizes pooling water. The center seam is double-sealed-lapped and riveted. The roof overlaps the sides and is riveted to the outer skin to ensure a weathertight seal. How do we know it's weatherproof? The rain test booth at the Holiday Rambler plant subjects roof and window seams to a torrential soaking to make sure.


31 CBXS HOLIDAY 1000 OPTIONS AVAILABLE: A, B






